## Safety Ruling “Unattended Children-Locker Room-Facility Use”

- **Coaches must be present and need to be the first ones to arrive at the Rink ...to supervise in locker rooms, practice areas, before, during, and after games. Coaches are responsible for the cleanliness and care of the room and adjacent areas. \* (Pertains to All Age Groups and Levels)**
- Parents or guardians need to know where their children are at all times and take responsibility for their actions.
- There will be no “Unattended Children” roaming anyplace in the rink or premises at any time including the Warm Room area as posted on the door.

### **IT IS IN NO WAY THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE RINK TO WATCH OVER CHILDREN ATTENDING ALL AND ANY OF THE FOLLOWING EVENTS, BUT NOT LIMITED TOO...**

Games, Practices, Public Skate, Stick and Puck, Birthday Parties, Private Rentals, all public and private events.

To ensure a safe and pleasant skating experience, please follow the rules listed below. Patrons using the rinks do so at their own risk and voluntarily assume all risk associated with any sport or event. The Penobscot Ice Arena does not accept responsibility for related risks or injuries. Users are personally responsible for ensuring they are fit to participate in physical activities. Anyone with a condition affecting his/her ability to participate must take appropriate safety precautions to ensure his/her own safety and is encouraged to be accompanied by an adult knowledgeable about their condition. “With some health conditions It may be unwise to participate in on ice activities. There is zero tolerance of any forms of abuse and/or harassment during skating. The Penobscot Ice Area reserves the right to dismiss a patron whose behavior endangers his/her own safety or the safety of others. Visitors should keep in mind this arena is a public resource and a place for fun and personal development for all ages and abilities; please help preserve a positive environment for all other visitors by honoring this Code of Conduct and reporting any violations to rink management. Your cooperation ensures all can enjoy this facility.

**The Penobscot Ice Arena is not responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged personal items. Always lock the bathroom door and front door when leaving the room unattended.**

- Keys must be checked out from the Skate Counter prior to use. The person signing out the key is responsible for the entire group using the locker room.
- Prior to occupancy, report any problems (damage/trash) to the Ice Arena Staff.
- A minimum of \$25.00 will be assessed to any group or individual that fails to return the locker room key or fails to leave the locker room in a clean and orderly condition. This includes picking up all tape and garbage, turning off showers and lights, includes stolen items, and/or damage to the facility
- The Penobscot Ice Arena tries to honor the stated gender identity of our patrons. Gender identity is not always apparent and does not always correspond with stereotypes about physical presentation of the Penobscot Ice Arena staff will NOT require identification to prove gender in order to access locker rooms. Groups using the locker rooms are expected to follow the intent of this statement.
- Organizations and groups renting ice will be held responsible for their members and guests.
